Introduction

Purpose:

The Strategic Plan is necessary to guide the work of all public health programs and services. This documentation reflects the areas that are to be a focus of the Burke County Health Department during the next three (3) year period (January 2021 through June 30th, 2024) given that funding and program requirements (agreements, grant, etc.) are sufficient:

Policy:

The health department shall develop a strategic plan that:

- Includes a review and analysis of factors influencing the health department's ability to improve the community's health (i.e., knowledge and expertise of Board of Health members and health department staff).
- Uses local health status data and information to set goals and objectives (i.e., community health assessment, state of the county health report, annual report).
- Uses community resources and input where applicable (i.e., perceptions of the public and partnering agencies as to what the department should be doing).
- States desired outcomes for each element, set priorities and.
- Uses community collaboration to coordinate resources to implement activities (i.e., Burke Wellness Initiative).

Burke County Health Department works as an integral organization in partnerships to detect and prevent disease, prepare, and respond to emergencies, protect the public from health threats and environmental hazards, evaluate programs, collaborate with other community partners and act as a catalyst for change, and educate our community about emerging and ongoing public health issues.



SWOT Analysis

The method of SWOT analysis is to take the information from an environmental analysis and separate it into internal (strengths and weaknesses) and external issues (opportunities and threats). Once this is completed, SWOT analysis determines what may assist an organization in accomplishing its objectives, and what obstacles must be overcome or minimized to achieve desired results.
